BPW Training Courses Information – 2019

Heavy axle program

Axle and suspension maintenance – 2 day course

This course covers the evolution of axle and suspension systems over the last ten years, and deals with maintenance and servicing issues. The course carries an examination on the second day in the afternoon.

Theory:

The focus areas are hub systems, drum brake, air suspensions, mechanical suspensions and turntables. A certificate is issued to all participants who have successfully passed the exam. The pass mark is 60%.

Practical: Drum brake axles

The focus areas are:

- Correct setting of automatic slack adjusters and brake chambers
- Assembly of camshaft and o-ring kit
- Stripping and assembly of the foundation brake
- Stripping and assembly of ECO^{Plus} up to ECO^{Plus} 3 hub assemblies
- Greasing intervals on axles
- Correct torque settings on axles and suspensions
